



At the Heart of the Preservation Area

The land mark of the farm called la Caillerie is adorned by a magnificent Oak tree which dominates the court yard with its beauty. Its central position enjoys light from all sides therefore giving it such grandeur.

The huge barn of vast proportions is typical of the barns and stables in this area.

The choice of farming is to favour maintaining the natural habitat of the area characterised by fields enclosed by hedges and woodlands. Also the shady pathways and wooded groves. The importance of this type of landscape maintains the biodiversity and quality of water and the continuity of the ecologic corridor which can be seen in Adriers and its surroundings.

It is in this way that the community is involved in this programme « Green and blue network » with a « citizen diagnosis » surveyed by volunteers along these communal paths.

These actions show the interest in protecting the natural and human environment and handing it down for future generations.
